

If you have checks, you will notice that your account number has an extra digit. Only give this extra digit on the account number if you are doing a "check by phone." An automatic ACH debit does not require the extra digit.

Joy Garcia Cocone! Recipient of the Robert E. Simpson Memorial Scholarship

The Robert E. Simpson Memorial Scholarship was established in 1961 to honor the first Superintendent of the Alhambra School District. He was killed in a traffic accident in February of that year. Teachers and community leaders came together to raise funds and establish the scholarship to aid Alhambra District graduates planning to enter educational careers.

The recently awarded scholarship will be the final one presented. The scholarship has helped many students over the past 54 years. Economic issues forced the reduction of principal to keep the amount of the award relevant.
